This CIF improvement scheme has tackled bringing a High School up to statutory requirements in terms of life safety and fire regulations.

Due to the nature of the work, the majority has been undertaken on twilight shifts, liaising closely with the School's Estate Manager. The project has involved life safety and fire improvements to the main three-storey building and four separate teaching blocks in a phased manner to suit the school.

This has included:

- A full asbestos survey and removal
- New fire alarm site wide and installation of emergency lighting and directional signage
- Removal of defective/non fire-rated doors and installation of new fire rated doors throughout
- Replacement of final exit doors
- Installation of fire compartmentation measures
- Installation of gas safety measures
